For new or returning students, the required documents must be received by the Higher Education Director by:

- July 15th for Fall Semester
- January 15th for Spring Semester
- May 15th for Summer Semester*

*Summer semester may be applied for, but only after prior approval from the Higher Education Director to catch those few credit hours that will enable the student to graduate the following Fall Semester.

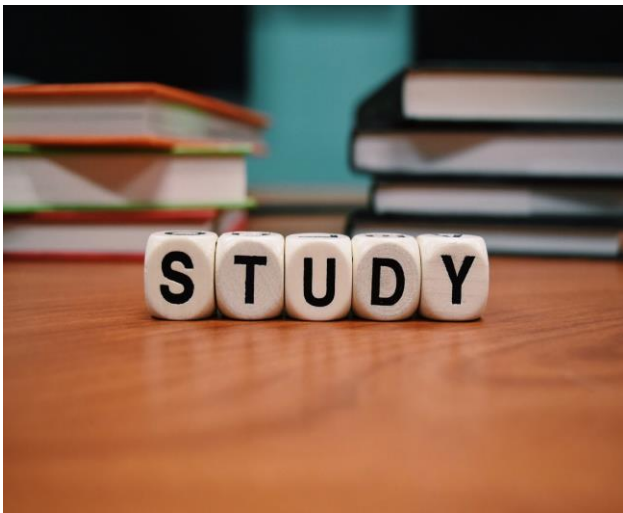

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Adult Education Program

The Adult Education Program provides training assistance to students who:

- Reside within the Ponca Tribe's Jurisdiction of Kay or Noble County. A utility bill (gas, water, electric,) rent receipt, or title of deed must be submitted as proof of residence.
- Will acquire certification in short term technical training (short term is defined as 4 months or under)
- Are applying for the G.E.D certificate
- Has a CDIB showing $\frac{1}{4}$ degree total Indian blood or member of a federally recognized tribe.

Higher Education Scholarship Application Process

1. Submit the Application for the Higher Education Scholarship. The Privacy Statement must be witnessed, signed, and dated.
2. You must be a member of the Ponca Tribe of Oklahoma. A CDIB is required.
3. You must write letter stating why you need a grant, how you plan to use the money, the college major you plan to pursue, and your objective after graduation from College/University. Sign and date the letter.
4. You must submit a copy of your letter of admissions from the college you plan to attend.



The Ponca Tribe believes education is vital to maintaining and growing a strong nation. The Ponca Tribe supports education activities that will lead to self-sufficiency and an improved quality of life.

Application Process (cont.)

5. Submit a copy of your High School or College Transcript (if you have previously attended college.)
 6. Submit the Financial Needs Analysis – it must be filled out by the Financial Needs Officer at your college/university.
 7. You must enroll in 12 college credit hours per semester in order to qualify for a full scholarship.
 8. You must enroll in an accredited College/University pursuing Bachelor's Degree.
- *You must request all necessary student aid application from the Financial Aid Officer of the college you propose to attend. This includes PELL, SEOG, OTAG, etc. This can be done online at FAFSA.gov**
